Recommendation 1: "Edmonds Community		
College has a comprehensive set of key		
performance measures with individual		
performance targets, although it is not clear		
how these are collectively used to define		
mission fulfillment. The evaluation panel		
recommends that Edmonds Community College		
provide both a definition of mission fulfillment		
and a corresponding acceptable threshold of		
mission fulfillment (Standard 1.A.2)."		L

Recommendation 2: "Edmonds Community College's core themes should collectively encompass the mission statement. The core themes should also contain a stronger alignment to essential elements of the mission statement. (Standard 1.B.1)."	
Recommendation 3: "Edmonds Community College should revise objectives to represent the institutional level of accomplishment of an essential element of the mission statement rather than as supporting activities or processes. The performance indicators should then be revisited to determine which existing measures support the revised objectives and which measures should be altered or eliminated. (Standard 1.B.2)."
