- Completion of an Edmonds Community College (ECC) Associate Degree that is compatible with an IUPUI academic program or at least 90 transferable Edmonds CC credits (grades of C or higher).
- Evidence of English proficiency: completion of ECC's English \_\_\_\_\_ with a grade of C or higher;
   iBT TOEFL 61, or IELTS 5.5.
- ECC minimum cumulative GPA 2.5;
- Submission of the following admission-related documents:
  - Official ECC transcript and complete academic records for all other post-secondary coursework;
  - o financial support document sufficient for one year of study at IUPUI;
  - o IUPUI international application for admission with \$60 application fee;
  - o A copy of your I-94 and current ECC I-20.
- Priority deadlines for admission to IUPUI are March 1 for Fall semester enrollment and October 1 for Spring semester enrollment.

Please note that the above requirements satisfy general requirements for transfer admission to IUPUI. Admission into competitive IUPUI programs is not guaranteed and depends on specific program admission requirements.

Do take advantage of meetings with your Academic Advisor at ECC to assure that the courses taken and credits earned at ECC will transfer to the degree program at IUPUI that you intend to complete. Congratulations upon your admission to the associate degree program at Edmonds Community College (EDCC). ## Transfer Agreement

International students completing an Associate of Science degree at Edmonds Community College with a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.5 or better are eligible for admission to compatible degree programs at the Purdue School of Engineering and Technology, Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI).

Transfer credit will be awarded for credits earned at Edmonds Community College when those credits meet requirements for compatible degree programs at the Purdue School of Engineering and Technology, IUPUI. Students should check with an academic advisor to determine which credits at Edmonds Community College apply to degree requirements at the Purdue School of Engineering and Technology, IUPUI. Course credits are not eligible for transfer when the student earns grades of C- or below.

Students should submit the completed form "IUPUI International Undergraduate Application for Admission" together with supplemental documents as stated on the application form checklist.

Students must also submit proof of English language skills. The normal requirement is submission of a TOEFL or IELTS score. The requirement for a TOEFL or IELTS score is waived, if the student completed ENGL 100 at Edmonds Community College and earned a grade of C or better.
