## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

**Les Roches International School of Hotel Management**

and

**Edmonds Community College**

Students having completed the Culinary Arts Associate of Technical Arts Degree at the Edmonds Community College, in addition to having completed the agreed upon required courses from the Business & Hospitality Program, are eligible to enter into semester 4 (Management year) having completed one internship prior to entry. An additional internship of 6 months will need to be completed before entry into Semester 6. To be eligible for the Les Roches Bachelor of Business Administration in International Hotel Management students will need to complete semesters 6 and 7. If appropriate, students need to show proof of 550 TOEFL, or equivalent, to enter semester 4.

This agreement is valid for 5 years or/but if the curriculum is altered before then, it requires approval. All publicity mentioning this agreement must be approved by Les Roches.
