Summer Tuition Discount

We are excited to announce a 25% tuition discount to all new international students enrolling full time in Summer 2026 and Summer 2027. Students receive a substantial savings of almost \$1,000.

\$500 Tuition Reduction Until Spring 2027!

Each new international student with an F1/F2 visa studying 12 or more High School, College, or ELI credits on campus or online will receive a \$500 tuition reduction for a maximum of 3 quarters until Spring Quarter 2027. This amounts to a tuition savings of \$1,500 to students! New students who enroll during Fall, Winter, or Spring will receive a \$500 discount for 3 quarters.

\$1,000 New Student Scholarship and More

Students can apply for a \$1,000 New Student Scholarship if they have minimum 3.3 GPA. More scholarships are available on our website at edmonds.edu/international/scholarships.
