OVERVIEW

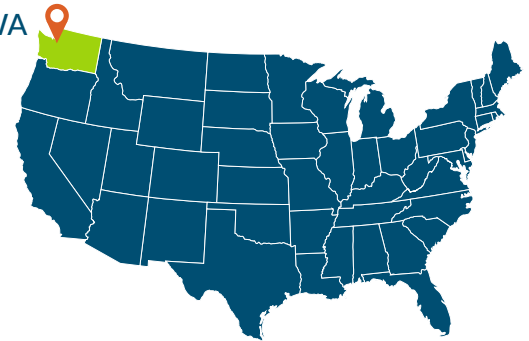

As one of our proudest achievements, Edmonds introduced the first and one-of-a-kind High School Completion Program to international students in Washington State and in the U.S. This program is designed to allow qualified students (16 years and older) to **to complete a Washington State high school diploma and earn a 2-year college degree transferable to universities in as fast as two years!**

On average, 100-200 international students enroll in our High School Completion Program each year. **Combining the unique advantages of small classes with college campus resources**, our students enjoy the benefits of strong student-to-faculty relationships, and a network of support for transition and academic success.

ADMISSIONS

To apply, please submit:

1. Completed new international student application that can be found online at edmonds.edu/international/how-to-apply
2. Students with one of the following test scores can begin the High School Completion program during their first term at Edmonds
 - CAMBRIDGE: First Certificate Grades A, B, C
 - DUOLINGO: 80 or higher
 - EIKEN (Step Eiken): 2A (2150 or higher)
 - ELS Program: Level 109
 - FLS: Level 14
 - IELTS: 5.0 (at least 4.5 in each band)
 - Institutional TOEFL: Not accepted
 - ITEP: Level 4
 - Kaplan: Higher Intermediate Level
 - LOEP: 73 or higher
 - Pearson Test of English (PTE): Score of 42
 - TOEFL: 54 (Writing 16)

If you don't have a test score, you can take our Institutional test, EXAMITY, online at edmonds.edu/testing/virtual-testing.html

For students not meeting the minimum English requirement, they can enroll in our **English Language Institute (ELI) program** and once completed can enroll in High School Completion.

3. Current bank statement with a minimum balance to cover amount of one year of student expenses. For updated amount, please go to edmonds.edu/international/how-to-apply
4. Copy of current passport
5. Official high school transcripts translated to English (including last year of middle school, junior high school, Secondary 3, or 9th grade)
Transcripts should include:
 - Name and address of school
 - Start and end date of each school term
 - Class or grade level
 - Courses taken and grades earned
 - Activities such as music, art, sports and clubs
 - Explanation of grading scale and credit hours (hours per week, per subject)
6. USD \$50.00 non-refundable application fee (currently waived)
7. For students under 18 years of age – please include the Waiver of Liability and Consent of Medical Information
8. Students 16 years old and older are admitted (15 year olds are eligible to enroll in online courses only from their home country)

WASHINGTON STATE HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA COURSE REQUIREMENTS

To earn a high school diploma, students in the High School Completion program must complete the following courses. Edmonds College will accept applicable high school courses taken in your home country to count towards the following requirements.

Edmonds College High School Completion Program (6 months to 2 years)

- English
- Math
- Science
- Arts
- U.S. History and Government
- P.E.
- Health
- Career and Technical Education
- Electives

**Washington state high school diploma requirements are subject to change.*

LENGTH OF PROGRAM

In addition to transferred credits, English proficiency is a main determinant of how fast a student can complete the program. Many students graduate a year ahead of their peers at home.

A college level English placement will start students in some college level courses and expedite the time to High School graduation. Academic English (AENGL: 2-4 courses) students can begin high school courses.
