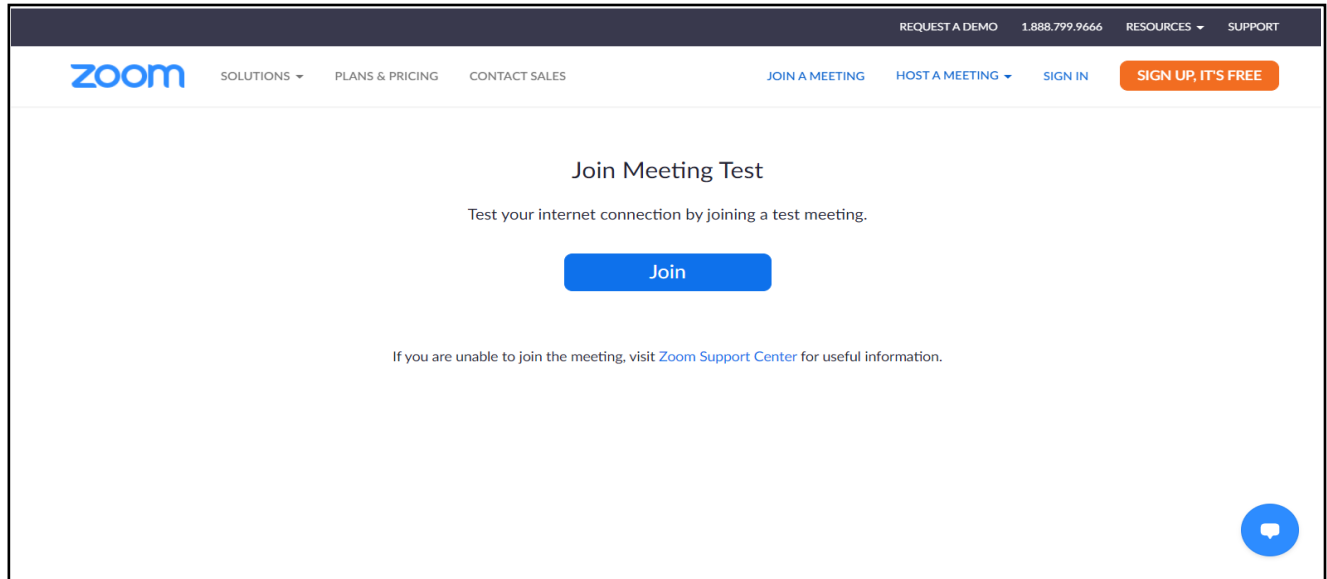
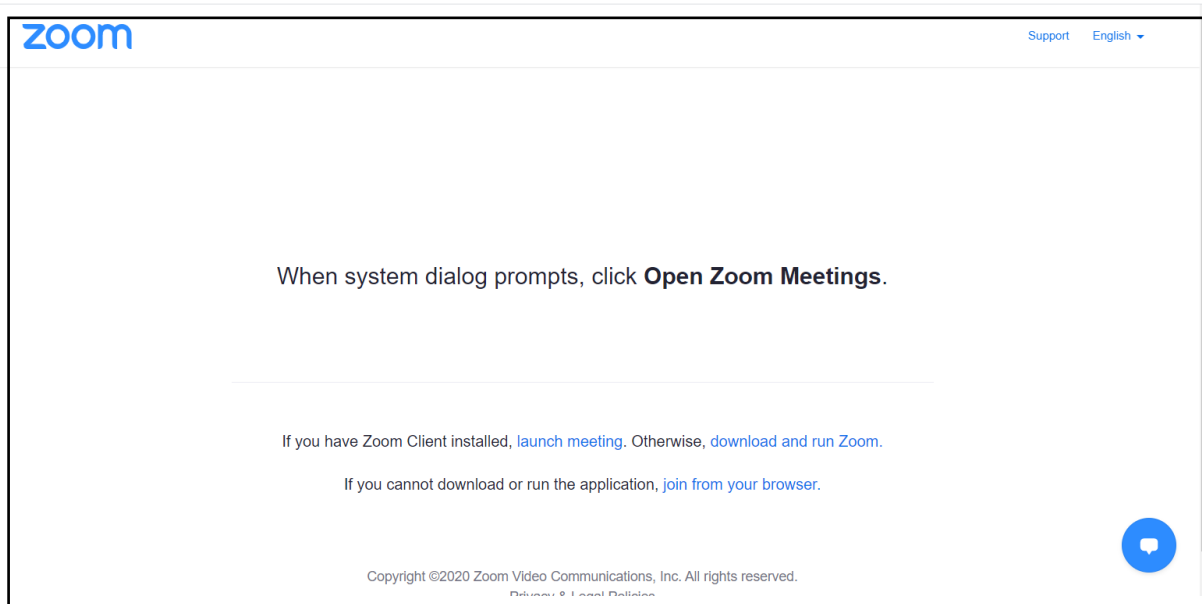


To see if you can log into a Zoom class or meeting and test your camera and audio connection, follow these steps.

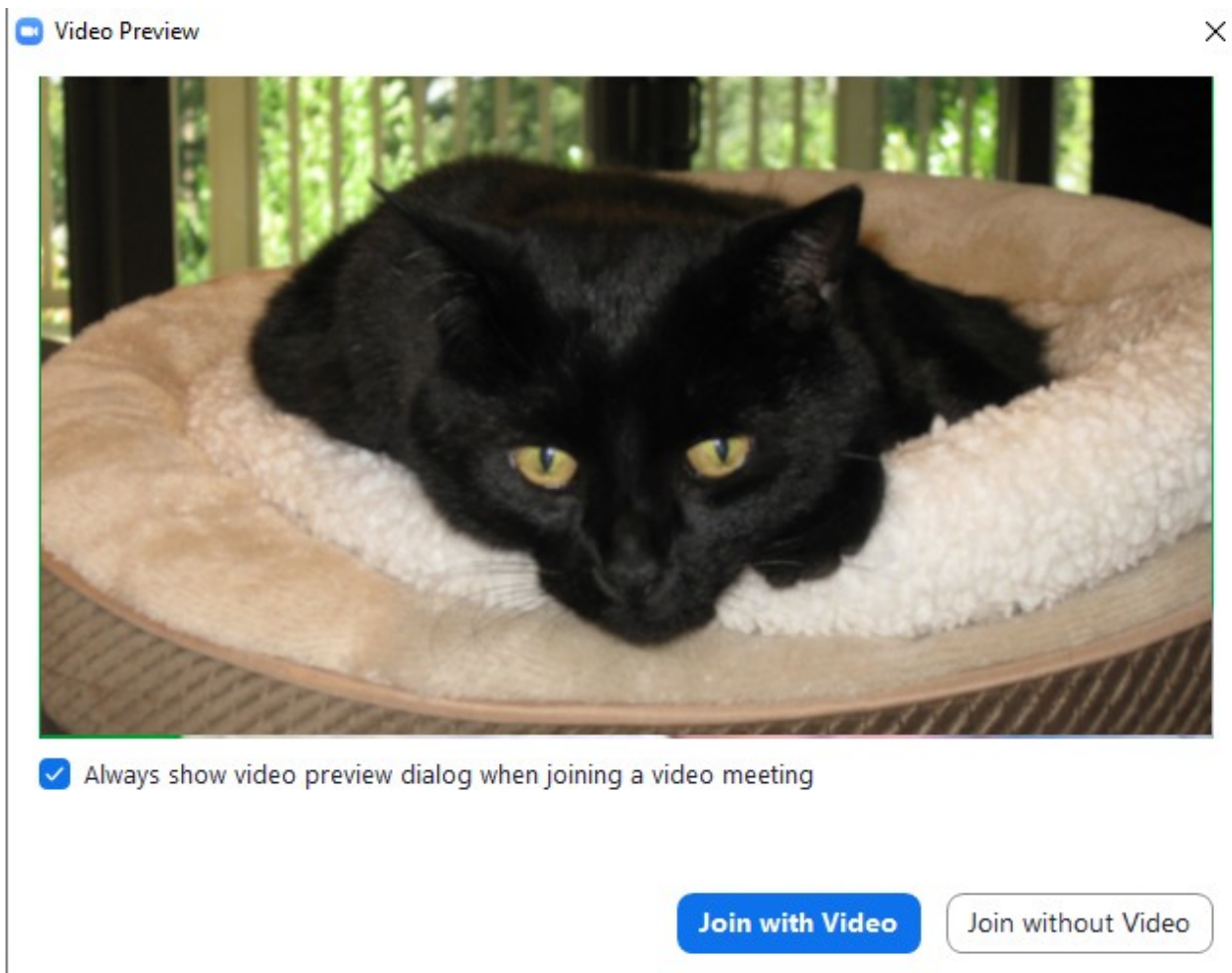
1. In your browser, go to zoom.us/test. You should see the following screen:



2. Click on Join. The following screen will come up:



3. If Zoom has already been downloaded to your machine, a window will open showing a video preview of what your camera is seeing if you have a working camera or web camera on your device. Click on Join with Video or Join without Video to join your test meeting.



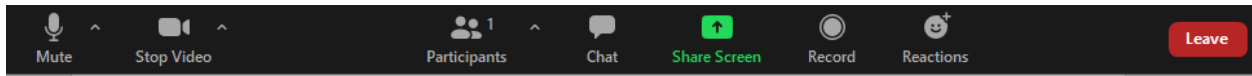
4. If Zoom has never been downloaded to your machine, click on one of options toward the bottom of the screen:

When system dialog prompts, click Open Zoom Meetings.

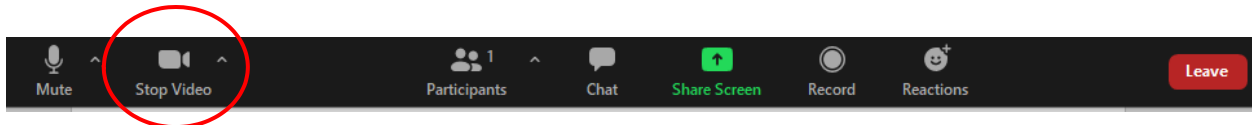
If you have Zoom Client installed, [launch meeting](#). Otherwise, [download and run Zoom](#).

If you cannot download or run the application, [join from your browser](#).

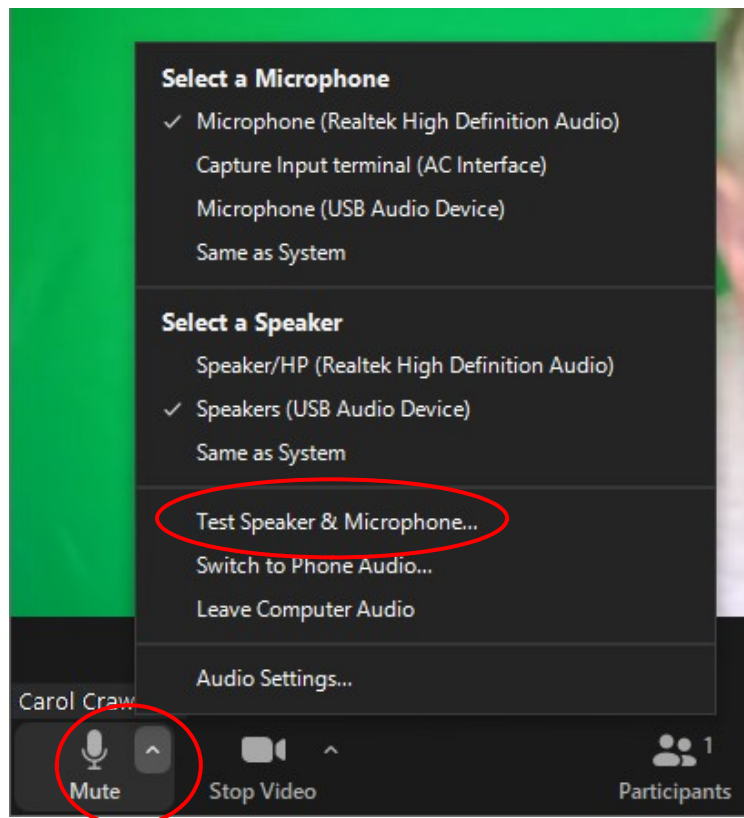
- Once you have joined the test meeting, the following tool bar will appear on the screen (may be at the bottom or top of the meeting screen). If you do not see the tool bar, move your cursor around and it should appear.



- If you joined without video, there might be a red bar across the camera icon indicating you are not using video. If you joined with video, you should be seeing what your camera is seeing (hopefully seeing your own image). Click on the camera icon to toggle the camera on and off.



- To test your audio, click on the up arrow to get the selection screen below. Click on Test Speaker & Microphone to test your audio system. Answer the questions about whether you hear a sound and speak and listen for a delay in what you said.
