What is Running Start?

Running Start is a statewide program that allows high school juniors and seniors to take college-level courses without paying tuition. Students receive both high school and college credit for classes completed at the college.

Who is Eligible?

All high school juniors and seniors are welcome, no matter their GPA, English placement, or post-graduation plans.

Where Will I Take Classes?

Students may enroll simultaneously in high school and college classes, or solely at the college. Classes are available in-person and online.

When Do Classes Meet?

Students may take classes during the day or evening.

How Much Does Running Start Cost?

Tuition is FREE! Students only pay for fees and textbooks. Fees are waived for students that meet certain income criteria.

Why Should I Enroll?

You can complete the first two years of a bachelor's degree, earn a certificate or associate degree while still in high school, or learn the skills you need to get a job right after graduating.
