



EDMONDS COLLEGE HOUSING APPLICATION PROCESS

Edmonds College offers housing to both domestic US students as well as international students enrolled at Edmonds College or Central Washington University on Edmonds College campus. We offer students the opportunity to live in our residential halls or in homestay with one of our program's host families. On-campus living provides students with connections and unique opportunities that can enrich and benefit their social and academic journeys.

Residence Halls

Prospective New Students

New students are assigned to the available spaces based on the date that they submitted their housing application along with the non-refundable housing application fee. While we make every effort to meet all of our new students' housing requests, we cannot guarantee that we can accommodate their first choices based on what we have available.

Placement order depends on the following:

- Date that we receive complete application including all items below:
 - Application including housing choices and preferences
 - Application fee
 - Other fees (if required)
 - Student's photo ID
 - Signed medical consent form (if required)
 - Arrival information
 - Background check form (if required)
- Gender
- Student's language
- Specific requests
- Special needs

Currently Enrolled Students

Students who are currently in housing will be asked during the last quarter of their lease what they would like to do once their lease expires. At that point, current students will have the option to renew their lease and continue living in Edmonds College housing or move out.

Past Housing Students

Students who have moved out of Edmonds College housing and want to move back in will need to email housing@edmonds.edu to let us know their intention of coming back as well as their housing preferences.

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Step 1

Turn in your complete application along with applicable fees.

Step 2

Watch for emails regarding missing items or other needed information.

Step 3

The placement process begins 1-2 months before the quarter starts. Shortly after placements are completed, you will be notified if you have been placed or if you will be on the waitlist.

Step 4

If you are sent placement, you will need to confirm your placement and inform us of your arrival date and estimated arrival time.

If you are on the waitlist, you will need to let us know if you want to stay on the waitlist in case any room opens up.

Step 5

Move in on arrival day!
